INAUGURAL ORGAN RECITAL Charles Andrews Professor of Organ, Royal College of Music Liturgical Organist, the Temple Church At last the rebuilding of the organ is finished! Thirteen years since the idea was first discussed, and 443 years since William Lambe's legacy was first given to enable the work to be done, we have managed to transform our rather poor organ into a fine new instrument ready to serve our musical needs in the 21st century. Despite all the difficulties and delays a large team has worked enormously hard - and now is the time to celebrate!

Do come and join with Bishop Stephen Oliver, the Corvus Consort and Professor Charlie Andrews on Sunday May 7th at 5pm for the Dedication. After Evensong there will be a drinks reception and then a fine organ recital during which the new instrument will be put through its paces. Not to be missed!



SUNDAY MAY 14th AT 11.15am Sadly the parish Annual General Meeting had to be postponed from April 23rd as that was the week of Fr John's cornea dystrophy operation. We do hope that there will be a good turn out for the meeting now set for May 14th. The meeting not only includes the election of Churchwardens and members of the Church Council (PCC) but also gives everyone an opportunity to contribute to the debate about the gifts we hope to receive from a new parish priest in 2024. It is good to have several
